What is an e-visa?

An e-Visa is an official document permitting entry into and travel within Egypt.

The e-Visa is an alternative to visas issued at the ports of entry.

Applicants obtain their visas electronically after entering required information and making payments by a credit or debit card.

The link to download your e-Visa will be emailed to you. Passport control officers at ports of entry can verify your e-Visa on their system.

As in the case of other visas, respective Egyptian officials at the ports of entry reserve the right to deny entry into Egypt to a holder of an e-Visa without any explanation.

You have to create an e-Visa application at least 7 days before your departure.

Who requires a visa to enter The Arab Republic of Egypt?

A citizen of a foreign country, wishing to enter The Arab Republic of Egypt, generally must first obtain an e-Visa via the Egypt e-Visa Portal.

You have to create an e-Visa application at least 7 days before your departure.

Note: Bangladesh is not included in the e-Visa list.

1) Passport:

- a. Original Passport with validity of minimum six months after the intended date of departure and minimum two blank pages for visa stamp.
- b. Copy of previous passports and visas issued.
- c. Attach all your old passports (if any).
- d. If any visa request was refused, details of original letter issued by the authorities of that country would be preferred.

2) Egypt Visa Application Form:

Visa application form must be filled and signed by the applicant.

3) Photo Specification:

Two recent passport size photographs with matt or semi matt finish, **60-80% face coverage**, white background and without border **(Size: 35mm x 45mm)**

Please Note: Photograph should not be more than 3 months old, scanned/stapled and should not be used in any of the previous visas.

4) Covering-Letter:

Covering Letter from applicant name, designation, Passport Number, purpose and outlining who will be responsible for the full costs of the trip – travel, accommodation, expenses etc. Addressed to – The Visa Officer, Embassy of Egypt, Dhaka.

5) Invitation Letter:

(If Any)

6) Forwarding-Letter:

a. Forwarding Letter / NOC from the applicant's company authority on the company's letter head stating applicant's name, designation, passport number, purpose and duration of visit.

b. Visa request letter from the educational institute or student card/evidence of school enrollment (if student)

7) Proof of Occupation:

a. Company registration certificate (original notarized English translated and photocopy of the original) if the applicant is a first time traveler or a proprietor.

b. Office ID card copy & Visiting cards.

8) Financials:

a. Company's or Personal Bank Statement for last six months mentioning the Bank's name, Bank's Telephone Number clearly.

b. Salary slip for the last six months. (If Any)

9) Ticket:

Ticket Itinerary & Hotel Booking.

Egyptian tourist/business visa is issued for a limited period of leisure travel and no business activities allowed. A visitor visa stamp or sticker placed by an Egyptian visa official on your passport that allows you to go to Egypt. Visitor visa for Egypt are usually issued by the Egyptian Embassy in Dhaka. When obtaining an Egyptian visitor visa, you can be expected to explain the reasons for visiting Egypt.

Visa fees

The type of visa you must have is defined by the Arab Republic of Egypt and Visa Regulations, and relates to the purpose of your travel. Tourism/Business visa is issued for single or multiple entries to persons whose nationalities require visas to enter Egypt.
